Application for Funding

This document outlines the application process and funding criteria for projects aligned with the mandate of Soroptimist International of Calgary.

Our mandate:

- Enhance the status of women and girls to achieve their full potential
- Work to enable women and girls to be free from all forms of violence and discrimination
- Promote a safe environment for women and girls with opportunities for advancement and pay equity

Funding Criteria and Application Process

- Projects must enhance the status of women and girls, promote safety and ensure pay equity
- Applications must be complete, using the specified format, and include a detailed budget with all revenue sources and expenses
- Acknowledge Soroptimist funding in all materials; volunteers from the organization must participate in Soroptimist fund raising events
- For projects over \$10,000.00, a final report and financial statement are required within three (3) months of project completion
- Applications must be submitted electronically by January 30 with all required attachments to Fund

Compliance and Declaration

- Authorized representatives must agree to use funds solely for the intended purpose and comply with all conditions
- Misuse of funds or false information may result in repayment obligations
- The application must be signed by the organization's President or Executive Director and one other authorized individual

How to Apply:

Proposals must include a completed, signed and dated Application for Funding together with:

- Attachment 1: Current Agency Financial Statements (audited if available)
- Attachment 2: Detailed description of project
- Attachment 3: Project budget

Only successful applicants will be notified.
